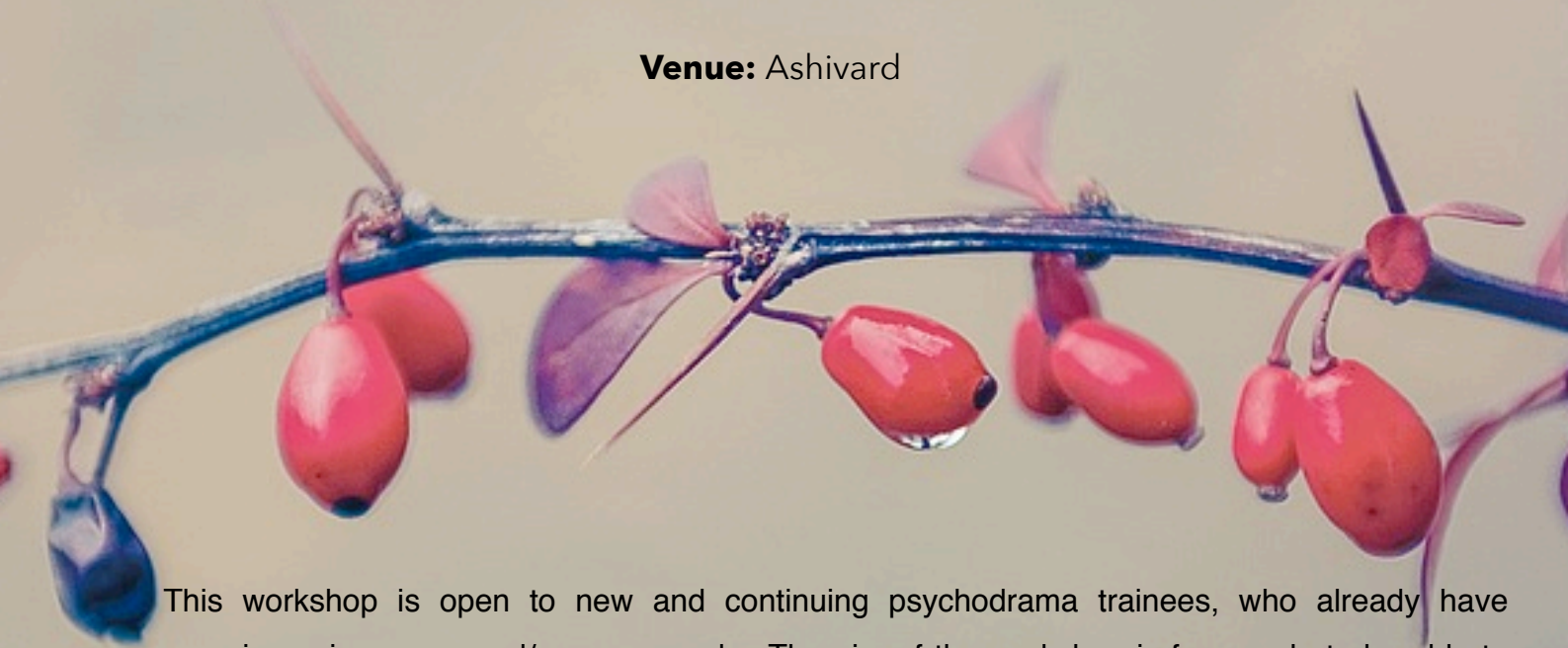


# IN THE SHOES OF THE OTHER

This workshop is open to new and continuing psychodrama trainees, who already have experience in groups and/or group work. The aim of the workshop is for people to be able to use the method in their work or life. It will therefore be of use to practitioners and supervisors. While the psychodrama method has many techniques that are applicable in groups, in a range of disciplines or fields, it also has many uses in one to one therapy or counselling practices and with couples and families. The material for this workshop will come from the participants. Each person can expect to have experience using the method in the large or in small groups and to learn or refine some of the theory and techniques during these two days.

The learning is experiential, with teaching and supervision occurring in the moment. Participants can expect to enjoy the training process, while gaining confidence and competence in the method. A reflection piece is required at the end of the workshop prior to each participant receiving a certificate for the course.
