For this 4-Day event, Friday through Monday, we are meeting online for 5 hours each day. The workshop is designed to accommodate several different world time zones. For example, Australia: 2.30-7.30pm, Aotearoa (New Zealand): 4.30-9.30pm, Japan: 12.30-17:30 and India: 9 am -2.30 pm.

Workshop Description: Life throws up new things constantly. With the advent of the coronavirus we've been presented with a challenge to the way we live and work. Developing new warm ups to every aspect of our living is essential. So many things get in the way of us expressing ourselves and doing the things we want to do. Spontaneity is the key. This workshop will give participants the opportunity to further hone and test their skills, ideas and concepts, develop new roles and gain new perspectives, to build and integrate both new and old roles to meet the moment. The practice of being in the 'here and now' is our methodology, with spontaneity at its core.

Who can apply: It is open to practitioners, trainees, group leaders and trainers across a range of disciplines, including the health and education fields. It will suit those who wish to apply psychodrama, role training and sociometry in their work and daily life, while gaining professional and personal development.

Workshop structure: All sessions need to be attended for a full learning experience. We start and finish on time each day. Confidentiality is observed, no recording of sessions or screen photos. An interview with the leader of the workshop is required. Whilst the focus of the workshop is on sociometry, sociodrama, role theory and psychodrama, the content will come from the group. The language is English (there will be no translation).

Leader: Sue Daniel (TEP) is an International Trainer, Director of the Psychodrama Institute of Melbourne, Founder of the Moreno Psychodrama Society and the Australian and Aotearoa (NZ) Board of Psychodrama. Joining her during the workshop will be Lethe Gaskin (NZ), Katrina Gaskin (Aus.), Jun Maeda (Japan) and Meenakshi Kirtane (India).
