The origins of 'chairwork' began at the Viennese Theatre of Spontaneity, in 1921. Since then chairs have been used as props in psychodramatic work, in groups and in one to one work. In this two-day experiential workshop participants will have an opportunity to practice their learning. This workshop will suit those working with individuals, couples and families, and in groups.



The Director of the workshop is Sue Daniel, world-wide psychodrama pioneer, Trainer, Educator and Practitioner of psychodrama (TEP), a psychologist (MAPS), and an individual and group psychotherapist living in Melbourne. Her work, since 1977, using a role theory approach is well known through her teaching and training in psychodrama institutes, universities, communities and conference presentations in over 30 countries.

In 2023 Sue is conducting a series of workshops in Australia and overseas (physically and online), entitled 'The Art of Chairwork', which have application in the workplace, home and community; in business, coaching, therapy, education and health fields.

The venue is situated in a sunny cobbled laneway near the beautiful Fitzroy Gardens.
