Explorations in Psychodrama is meeting online on the 1st Monday of the month from 7.30-9.30pm, from February to December (10 sessions).

Dates:

5 February, 4 March, (no April), 6 May, 3 June, 1 July, 5 August, 2 September, 7 October, 4 November & 2 December 2024.

The group is specifically designed for those who participated in the previous series. It provides a unique opportunity for like-minded people to connect and share in a safe group environment. It also offers a great opportunity to learn specific psychodrama techniques tailored for the onscreen environment. For example, how to maintain your spontaneity when you are doing zoom. Methodology includes sociometry, role theory and psychodrama. It is an experiential group with some theoretical input. The material will come from the group. Participants will have the opportunity to experience the fullness of the Morenian psychodrama method online.

The maximum number in the group is 9.

The fee is \$AUD45.00 per session (payable online in Australian dollars on the day).

Sue Daniel is the leader for these sessions. She is the director of the Psychodrama Institute of Melbourne, and founder of the Moreno Psychodrama Society and the Australian and Aotearoa Board of Psychodrama. From the beginning of the era of Coronavirus (March 2020) she has been regularly counselling, teaching and practising psychodrama in Australia and other countries via the Zoom Platform.

Other psychodrama workshops in 2024 include 'Living Today' 10-11 Feb; 'Our relationship with Our Self and Others' 11 & 12 May; 'Gifts from the Past' 27 & 28 Jul; 'Our Group Relations', 31 Aug-1 Sept; 2 x 4 week Case Study courses:-7-28 May, (South Yarra) or 8, 15, 22 & 29 May (Online) from 8-9.30pm (AEST).
