The Tuesday Series: 7-28 May 2024

This course is conducted over 4 consecutive weeks in May. It is designed particularly for those working in private practice or conducting groups. Focus will be on particular issues or scenarios, of people or groups, within a real world context. Participants can expect to increase their knowledge of role theory, role training and sociometry and the specific and judicious use of psychodramatic techniques. The sessions will involve role analysis, sharing and discussion. The material will come from the group.
