

4-Day International Psychodrama Intensive: 'Our Precious Relationships'

In this 4-Day workshop, we will have the opportunity to meet in true psychodramatic encounter in a physical workshop. The workshop is based on sociometry, sociodrama, role theory and psychodrama. As humans we are born into the group and as such are 'group beings'. Without the group we would not survive. Through these relationships we learn about the world and each other. These relationships change over time, people come and go and our groups change. It's important to think about this. Participants can expect to learn about group life, what kind of relationships do we want, who or what has shaped us, who is significant in our life? In this workshop we will shine a light on our relationships, past, present and future, with people, our environment (including animals and objects), and see what can evolve afresh. All sessions need to be attended for a full learning experience. There are 8 x 3-hour sessions over the four days, with breaks for refreshments and lunch each day.

The workshop is open to practitioners, trainees, group leaders and trainers across a range of disciplines, including the health and education fields.
